### PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

**Dr. Juliana de Albuquerque** completed her PhD Thesis in University college Cork in November 2021, having received a Masters degree in Philosophy from Tel Aviv University and her Bachelors Degree in Brazil.



Her academic activities in UCC have included teaching German intellectual history, and German Jewish thought and literature, from the age of the Enlightenment to pre-War Germany.

Juliana is also an associate researcher at the Center for Jewish Studies at the University of São Paulo, Brazil and is coordinating a research group dedicated to the study of Contemporary Jewish Philosophy and Politics. The group focus on the discussion of literary and philosophical texts related to the theme of the Dialogue between Jews and Germans.

**Amna Walayat** is a Cork based Pakistani visual artist. She has an MA in Fine Arts from Punjab University Lahore and an MA in Art History Theory and Criticism from UCC. Her practice is based on expressing her hybrid cultural experiences and her position as a migrant artist. In promoting South Asian Art in Ireland, she has established Pakistan Ireland Arts Exchange.



She is currently working on her South Asian community-based project as Creative Producer in residence with cork County council. She is the recipient of a number of awards from the Arts Council.
