VOCATIONS IRELAND EXECUTIVE UPDATE

At our strategic meeting in Roscrea we worked on the Mission and Vision Statement in line with the Mission and Vison of AMRI. We agreed that we would work to develop a collaborative working strategy with AMRI that would enable us to provide education and formation on creating a culture of vocation. This would be done through workshops, conferences, and webinars. Our office would be responsible for highlighting to members vocation promotion opportunities such as career events, the ploughing championships, Youth 2000 retreats and similar opportunities as they arise. We agreed to work on the development of engagement with our second and third level students through coffee & chat opportunities, panel discussions during R.E. classes and the provision of webinars for teachers. We continue to receive inquiries and refer these inquiries to the appropriate congregations. We had a second meeting with input from Sr Lynn Levo to help deepen our relationship with AMRI and manage the move from being a charity to an organisation that is both a company and a charity. This move brings us under the human resources structures of a company and our Vocation Committee is now part of the AMRI staff team with leadership, justice, and communications. This team approach expands our horizons and enables us to promote the culture of vocations to a wider audience. It also allows for better communication with vocation promotors, leadership and formators, thus enabling a clearer understanding of each person's role during the different stages of formation. We also continue to offer training workshops in Vocation Promotion , Vocation Ethics, Behavioral Assessments, Psychological Assessments, Culture awareness, accompaniment and communications, social media etc.
